an awareness of life and living.

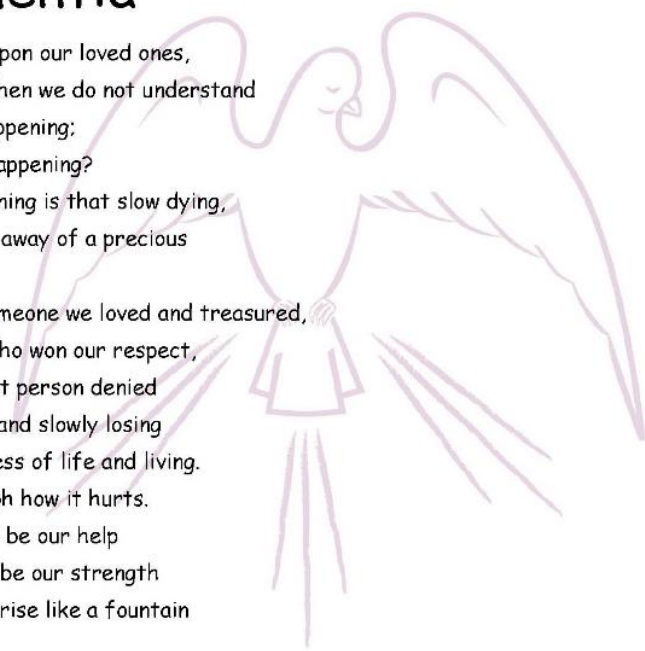
It hurts...oh how it hurts.
